The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must purchase any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

All services outlined are based on a 20 mile radius from our home office. Extra fees may apply for additional mileage and excess travel time. As a service to all our families, we provide a complimentary service announcement on our website to let the community know whether there are public services or not.

“Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.”

Methods of Payment:

Payment for goods and services is expected prior to the services being rendered. For your convenience we accept cash, check and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express) although with the use of a debit or credit card there is a 3% processing fee added to the total charge. We also accept the use of Life Insurance Policies as a guarantee of payment. If accepted, an insurance assignment processing fee of 5% or a minimum of \$125 will be charged.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff **\$605**

Our non-declinable basic fee covers a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs such as utilities, staff availability 24/7, the initial conference for arrangement, preparing and filing of necessary documents, authorizations and permit required for disposition, communications and schedule coordinating between business offices and supporting staff at crematory, care center and/or providing transportation.

Event Planning - Tier 1 **\$90**

Consultation meeting, assistance with selection of up to 2 merchandise items, assistance with online obituary and procurement of US Flag (if eligible veteran).

This may also be applicable with persons being shipped out of state (within the US).

Event Planning - Tier 2 **\$300**

Consultation meeting and follow up if needed, assistance with selection of up to 3 merchandise items, assistance with online obituary, procurement of US Flag, submission for honor detail request with appropriate branch of service (if eligible veteran), assistance with coordinating clergy/celebrant or cemetery details.

Event Planning - Tier 3 **\$600**

Consultation meeting and follow up meetings, assistance with selection of 4+ merchandise items, assistance with online obituary, procurement of US Flag, submission for honor detail request with appropriate branch of service (if eligible veteran), assistance with coordinating clergy/celebrant, assistance with coordinating offsite location including private or national cemetery, assistance with catering selections if held onsite.

Embalming **\$595**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

WillowBridge offers a variety of caskets suitable for burial or cremation, alternative containers, urns and keepsakes. An "alternative container" is an unfinished wood box or other non-metal receptacle or enclosure, without ornamentation or a fixed interior lining, which is designed for the encasement of human remains. It is made of fiberboard, pressed-wood, composition materials or like materials, with or without an outside covering. **A complete price list will be provided at the funeral home.**

Basic Packages

Direct Cremation

\$1500 – \$4895

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; transfer of deceased to funeral home; refrigeration up to 5 days, and the cremation fee.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of these materials and interiors may be added.

Immediate Burial

Immediate burial is the minimum service offered for disposition of remains in a cemetery. This service includes: basic services of funeral director and staff plus Tier I planning; a proportionate share of overhead costs; transfer of deceased to funeral home; refrigeration up to 5 days, placing shrouded remains into casket selected (purchased separately) and delivery for committal. This is a non-witnessed or attended interment.
